GOOGLE ADVANCED SEARCH OPERATORS

define: truths Show a list of definitions for truths

allinanchor: query All query words must appear in anchor text of links to the page.

inanchor: query Terms must appear in anchor text of links to the page.

allintext: query All query words must appear in the text of the page.

intext: query The terms must appear in the text of the page.

allintitle:query Restrict the results to those with all of the query words in the title.

intitle:query Restrict the results to documents containing that word in the title.

allinurl:query Restrict the results to those with all of the query words in the URL.

inurl:query Restrict the results to documents containing that word in the URL.

filetype: query Find documents of the specified type.

cache:www.example.com Google's cache of example.com

site:www.example.com List all webpages hosted at www.example.com

info:www.example.com Show information that Google has about www.example.com

movie: movie name Find movie showtimes, reviews and ratings.

weather: city name Given a location (state or city), show the weather

safesearch: sex education Search for sex education material without returning adult site

Note: There should be no space left between the operator and query string.

Games: -inurl:(htm|html|php|freebsd|linux|netbsd|jsp|phtml|shtml|distfiles) intitle:"index of" "parent directory" (.iso|.mdf|.nrg|.rar|.exe) "Game Name"
Software: -inurl:(htm|html|php|asp|jsp) intitle:"index of" "last modified" "parent directory" description size (.exe|.rar|.zip|.iso|.nrg|.mdf) "Software Name"
